



# Julius Caesar

## New England Tour - 2010

Bring Shakespeare to your school! Each year, a team of seven Shakespeare & Company actor/teachers will travel throughout the northeast, performing a 90-minute production of *Julius Caesar*. Our emphasis is on language, pleasure in playing, and the relationship that exists between the actors and the audience. The actors create wonderful rapport with students, and while they make Shakespeare immediate and accessible, they never dumb it down. This program has operated annually since 1982, and reaches over 25,000 students each year. A performance of *Julius Caesar* comes with either one of the following 45-minute workshop for students:

### Workshop in Performance

In this workshop, students surprise themselves and each other by creating their own Shakespeare performances. The actors work closely with small groups of students to unleash an exciting, immediate, and personal experience of Shakespeare's language. In this workshop each student can succeed and discover that Shakespeare is accessible, outrageous, and immediately engaging. They also perceive their classmates in new and delightful ways. This workshop can be based on any of Shakespeare's plays and works best with 30-40 students or fewer - the absolute maximum is 50.

### Actor-Audience Workshop

This workshop gives students the opportunity to be directors. The actors perform short scenes and then invite students to suggest other ways in which the scenes might be played. Students gain first-hand experience about what it means to rehearse a scene and learn there is no "right way" to perform a play. This workshop is ideally suited for a post-performance audience, with a suggested participation limit of 200 students.
